

## JROTC PROGRAMS

The Falcons Landing Chapter of MOAA actively supports two Junior ROTC units in our area of responsibility, the Air Force JROTC unit at the Chantilly Academy in Fairfax and the Navy JROTC unit at Loudoun County High School. The Chapter President and Director of JROTC Programs present four scholarships to cadets at each school including the Lieutenant General John Pustay Scholarship which is awarded to a selected cadet at the Chantilly Academy.

In addition to the Scholarship Program, the Chapter participates in the MOAA JROTC Award Program at each high school.

Junior ROTC (JROTC) medals are used to recognize an outstanding cadet or midshipman in his or her next-to-last year in the program who has demonstrated exceptional potential for military leadership. All military services officially have approved the medal for presentation.

To be eligible for an award, a candidate must

- be in the next-to-last year of an ROTC or JROTC program;
- be in good academic standing;
- be of high moral character;
- demonstrate a high degree of loyalty to the unit, school, and country; and
- demonstrate exceptional potential for military leadership.
